- Submission deadline is March 1, 2010.

- Photographs must be sizeable to 8" X 10".
- Black and White or Color photos are acceptable.
- All photographs must be original works, taken by the artist with a camera. Use of another's photograph or artwork will result in disqualification.
- Photographers must sign a release allowing all submitted photos to be auctioned as fundraising material, and all proceeds will be donated to Elder Options.
- For liability purposes, we require a signed release by both the photographer and subject (when applicable). Official releases may be printed from our website, or you may request a copy mailed/faxed.
- Judging will be performed by Elder Options staff and select guest judges. Judging will be based on style, technique, subject matter, and emotive quality.
- There is no limit to digital post-processing effects. Please provide a brief description of effects added to each submission. (A brief description of the subject and the artist's point-of-view is also encouraged.)
